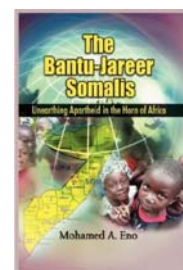
Congratulations to H.E. Dr. Noun Samphea

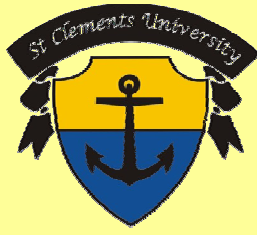

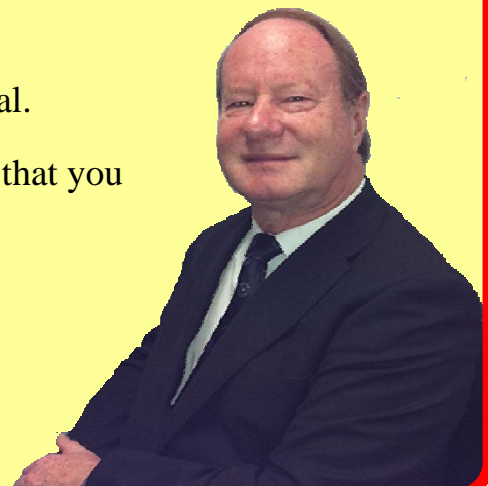
